Here's my report on the events.

In America, the situation is getting worse and worse. Right now, in Ecuador, MariCarmen mentions that there are coronavirus deaths on the streets and in homes and that the health sector is not collecting them; this is also mentioned on Facebook. There is a lot of information about coronavirus, especially in the health sector. Hygiene measures to avoid it: suspension of classes at all levels of education, curfews, the military national guard of countries protecting the population; because of the lack of food and employment, attacks have increased in supermarkets. The critical phase of protection has increased, adults aged 60 or over are advised to confine themselves to their homes and not to go out to avoid contagion, as they are the most vulnerable and will be difficult to care for in the health sector.

Food is said to be scarce in Bolivia and other countries. Team members, worried about the events, are motivated by Whatsapp. Father Jean and Father José Sirvin are quarantined as is the population. Cuba has sent doctors to several countries to collaborate. In Colombia, the situation is disturbed by events in that country concerning politics and health. The world's anxiety is contaminating the believers' faith.

Haiti and El Salvador do not communicate about events. The Dominican Republic and other countries are taking care of themselves at home, to avoid contagion as much as possible. Most activities are suspended in Latin America and the Caribbean.

The newsletter Among Us circulates through the electronic media, which is greatly appreciated.

In Mexico, it was communicated yesterday that we will not return to class until April 30, the period has been extended due to the critical phase that will become more pronounced, (it had been mentioned that perhaps we would work in July, nothing was said, many things are said through the electronic media. And maybe we even would not go back to class until August, this has not been officially confirmed by any authority).

With the anxiety that we are feeling at the moment because France is, according to the media, in the table of countries with the most problems with the coronavirus, my fellow coordinators, Jose Ramirrez and the other members of the team send you their affection and warm hugs.
